

Research and Graduate Education Advisory Committee

The College of Human Sciences Research and Graduate Education Committee advises the Dean, Associate Dean for Research, and the Director of RISE on matters related to research and graduate education in the College. In particular, the Committee should:

- Provide recommendations for policies and procedures for research and graduate education in the College of Human Sciences to the graduate faculty and Cabinet of the College.
- Review proposals submitted for internal university research grants.
- Make recommendations for appropriate research resources for faculty, staff and students.

Selected members of the committee should:

- Review guidelines for scholarships, solicit eligible graduate students, and select recipients.
- Oversee the Master of Family and Consumer Sciences graduate program, setting policies and procedures, and serving as the admissions committee for the Comprehensive Track.

Structure: Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Studies, DOGE from each department, 1 tenure-track faculty member; ex-officio representative from RISE.
