ISU Teacher Education Services, College of Human Sciences Career Services, and the School of Education are partnering to host the 3rd annual Teacher Education Career Fair. The career fair is scheduled for March 6, 2017 at the ISU Alumni Center- conveniently located between Jack Trice Stadium and Hilton Coliseum. All students within the ISU Education Preparation Program are invited to attend the career fair to meet with districts/organizations. The career fair is also open to the general public. We anticipate approximately 400 attendees.

Payment

The registration fee is \$50 per booth for all districts and organizations. This fee includes a 6' skirted table, Wi-Fi, electricity (upon request), parking, and unloading/set up assistance. Lunch will be provided prior to set up. There is a limit of two recruiters per booth, at one time. Booths will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, according to the date of registration. The registration deadline is February 13, 2017 to be included in promotional materials.

Interview Day: March 7, 2017

You may also sign up to conduct on-campus interviews the day after the fair with students you meet. If you select this option, we will provide a blank interview schedule for you to fill at the fair. Participating in on-campus interviews gives you the opportunity to:

1. Meet with students with whom you connected at the career fair.
2. Build on the relationship you established with promising students during the career fair.
3. Continue to build your employer brand with students and establish a greater presence on campus.
